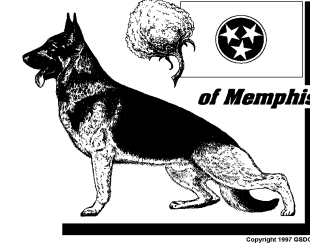

Routes To The Show

FROM MEMPHIS—On I-40 going west, take Exit 241A and turn south. This will take you directly to the hotel.

FROM FORT SMITH OR LITTLE ROCK—On I-40 going east, take Exit 241A and turn south. This will take you directly to the hotel.

Water and Electricity will be available for bathing and drying dogs. **NO** bathing dogs in the rooms. Damage deposits may be required at check in. **PLEASE BE A COURTEOUS GUEST AT THE MOTEL.**

Notice to Exhibitors: Telegraph, Telephone, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms, and photocopies of Entry Forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable.

A Recording Fee and Event Fee will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Fees are to be collected on the first entry only.

Dogs need to be present only at the scheduled time of judging. No entry can be accepted unless the signatures of the owner or his/her duly authorized agent is affixed to the line at the bottom of the entry form.

The Club and its Show Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This Club and its Show Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agent entering a dog twice or in a class for which the dog is ineligible to compete.

Entry fees must accompany entries. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, in season (exception – Obedience), or excused by the Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete because it is incorrectly entered. If because of riot, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Confirmation of entry and judging schedule will be sent to the address on the Official AKC Entry Form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Judging Schedule within seven days, the Show Secretary should be contacted.

Exhibitors please note: effective for all shows held on or after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owner's records, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the start of judging at the show. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6, Amended to December 10, 1996)

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Club will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

All prizes will be awarded in the ring. The club reserves the right to substitute any trophy with one of greater or equal value if conditions make it necessary. No trophies will be mailed.

The show giving club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other causes and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the show giving club or any official thereof.

Note: Foreign dogs are eligible for Puppy Classes and Open Classes effective January 1, 1985.

The welfare of the Exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show.

Management is not responsible for the loss of, damage to, or death of any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any participant, whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at the show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

The GSDC of Memphis, its Show Secretary, Proprietors of this Show Site, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors, handlers, their employees or children, etc., or to any of the dogs or property. Entrants and Spectators to the show do so entirely at their own risk.

Single copies of the latest editions of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and *Obedience Regulations* may be obtained WITHOUT CHARGE from any Superintendent at any show where they are superintending or from THE AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB, 5580 Centerview Drive, Raleigh, NC 27606-3390.

AGREEMENT

I (we), acknowledge that the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and, if this entry is for an Obedience Trial, the *Obedience Regulations*, have been made available to me (us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (we) waive any and all claims, causes of action, I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC-approved judge, judging at this show, under AKC Rules, Regulations and Guidelines. I (we) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show or obedience trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or obedience trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show or obedience trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
